ADMINISTRATION OF SUMMATIVE TEST FOR THE SY 2022-2023

To: Education Program Supervisors
Public Schools District Supervisors
Elementary and Secondary School Heads
District/School Testing Coordinators
All Teachers

- 1. Relative to the Division Memorandum No. 491, s. 2022, the administration of the Diagnostic Test last October 20-21, 2022, this Division through the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID) will administer the Summative Test on June 19-20, 2023 in Four (4) learning areas in the morning of day 1 and the remaining Four (4) learning areas will be in the morning of day 2. To be specific, Filipino, English, Araling Panlipunan, and TLE/EPP is to be administered in day 1, and EsP, Mathematics, Science and MAPEH will be administered on day 2. For Special curriculum, the school head and school testing coordinators shall make a list of subjects intended for day 1 and day 2. Test materials can be downloaded using the link (https://bit.ly/pang2summativetestfiles). Reproduction of the test materials will be done by the school through their MOOE/or other school funds.
- 2. The summative test has the following objectives:
 - a. gauge learners' level of mastery on the Most Essential Learning Competencies (MELCs);
 - b. evaluate effectiveness and efficiency of instructional delivery using learning outcomes indicator;
 - c. provide information to improve pedagogical practices; and
 - d. formulate evidence-based policies, plans, intervention programs that impact learning outcomes.
- 2. Checking of answer sheets shall be done in every afternoon in order to accomplish immediately the frequency of correct responses, the Mean the Mean Percentage Score (MPS), and the mastery level. Submission of the required reports is due on June 26, 2023 in a soft copy using the link to be forwarded by the Division Test Coordinator.
- Travel and other incidental expenses of the participants shall be charged to local school funds subject to the usual auditing and accounting procedures.
