## **PARTICULARS**

The Philippine Elementary School Principals Association (PESPA) Pangasinan II Chapter will hold its 6<sup>th</sup> PESPA Pangasinan II Congress Cum Upskilling & Reskilling Workshop with the theme: Flexible School Leadership: The Strategic Response for Academic Continuity Amid & Beyond the Pandemic at Hotellinda Suites, Rivero St. Barangay 8, Vigan City on February 22-24, 2022.

The activity aims to: enable the PESPA officers and members enhance their leadership and management knowledge, mindset and skills to provide support in the readjustment and catching up of the learning losses caused by the pandemic; project goals for academic recovery and education continuity; impart the values of learning from one another as a group; understand and apply new guidelines and implementing rules in the recruitment and selection of teachers to make teaching a rewarding profession.

The target participants are the DepEd Division PESPA officers and members, all registered School Heads (Principals, Head Teachers, Teachers-in-Charge/ Officers-In-Charge) of Pangasinan SDO II. Attendance of the participants is on **OFFICIAL BUSINESS**.

A registration fee of Six Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (Php. 6,500.00) shall be charged from each participant to defray the costs for food, hotel accommodation, honorarium of speakers, training materials and other incidental expenses chargeable against School MOOE/ local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

Arrival and registration of participants shall be on February 22, 2023 (Day 1). The first meal to be served will be the PM snacks of Day 1 and the last meal will be lunch of February 24, 2023 (Day 3).

In compliance to the Department of Health (DOH) and Inter-Agency Task Force (IATF) health protocols, the participants shall observe maximum health standards and other policies like wearing of face masks for the whole duration of the training. They are also requested to bring sufficient face masks and alcohol including their vaccination cards.
