- 4. There will be conference of the Technical Working Group at Pozorrubio Central School on October 18, 2023 at 10AM.

- 5. No registration fee, however, meals and snacks for the participant and coach will be provided by the participating district. Travel expenses can be charged to local funds subject to usual accounting procedures.

QUIZ BEE MECHANICS ON CLIMATE CHANGE CARAVAN 2023

- 1. Each district shall send 1 learner from Grade 5.
- 2. The learner shall present his or her ID and Certificate of Enrolment for verification prior to competition proper.
- There shall be three (3) rounds in the contest.
 - Round 1- Easy
 - Round 2- Average
 - Round 3-Difficult
- 4. The questions shall revolve on the following topics on Climate Change:
 - Food Security (FS)
 - Water Sufficiency (WS)
 - Ecological, and Environmental Stability (EES)
 - Human Security (HS)
 - Climate-friendly Industries and Services (CIS)
 - Sustainable Energy (SE)
 - Knowledge and Capacity Development (KCD)
- 5. There shall be ten (10) questions for Round 1, ten (10) for Round 2, and five (5) for Round 3. Each question weighs one (1) point for Easy round, (2) points each for average, (3) points each for Difficult and (5) points each for Clincher round in case there is a tie.
- 6. In case of a tie, Clincher Round shall be conducted. The first contestant to get the correct answer shall be declared as winner.
- 7. The questions for Easy and Average Round shall be multiple choice, while questions for the Difficult and Clincher Round shall be identification or fill-in the blanks.
- 8. The Technical Working Group shall prepare the questions for the Quiz Bee.
- 9. A TWG shall composed of Quiz Master, Timer, Scorer, and Checker for each contestant to facilitate the competition.
- 10. Cellular or mobile phones are not allowed during the contest proper.
- 11. The Quiz Master shall read the question twice.
- 12. The contestant shall write their answer on the slate board provided after hearing the word "GO" from the Quiz Master.
- 13. The contestant shall be given 10 seconds to write their answer on the slate board for Easy and Average Rounds. 15 seconds shall be given to the contestants to write their answer in the Difficult and Clincher Rounds.
- 14. The Quiz Master shall say the word "STOP" after the allotted number of seconds in each round and shall proceed in checking the answers. Failure to follow instructions constitutes the first offense which means warning and disqualification for the second offense.
- 15. Any question or clarification about the correctness of the answers should be raised before the start of the next question by the contestants.
- 16. A panel of judges shall decide on the question or query and their decision is final and irrevocable. The top 3 contestants based on their total scores are:
 - Champion
 - First Runner-up
 - Second Runner-up
