Call for the Submission of Action Research Proposals for SY 2023-2024

- 1. Pursuant to the initiatives of the Department towards strengthening evidence-based policy formulation and decision making in all levels of governance, this Office announces the call for the submission of action research proposals for SY 2023-2024.
- 2. Action Research proposals to be submitted by Elementary/ Junior High School/ Senior High School Teachers shall focus on learning recovery interventions in the classroom. More specifically, proposed innovation, intervention, and strategy of the proposal shall focus on 4th quarter learning gaps.
- 3. **The submission shall be on or before February 5, 2024.** Three (3) printed copies of the research proposal shall be submitted Please be guided by the provisions stated in DepEd Order No. 16, s. 2017 (Research Management Guidelines).
- 4. **Only the School Research Committee (SRC)** both for the elementary and secondary schools is advised to ensure that all research proposals have been fully screened before endorsing them to the Division Office. Attached is the evaluation tool for action research proposals for ready reference of the SRC.
- 5. The SDRC secretariat shall conduct the initial division level screening of submitted proposals against the eligibility requirements. Proposals falling under the following conditions will not be further evaluated, and will immediately be returned, with technical inputs, to the proponents:
 - 5.a. Incomplete documentary requirements as prescribed during the call for proposals:
 - 5.b. Conflict of interest in personal and professional aspects, which may influence the impartiality of the proponent;
 - 5.c. Non-conformance to research ethics:

- 5.d. Non-alignment of research topic with the national and local Basic Education Research Agenda particularly teaching and learning.
- 6. Action Research proposals submitted and defended last school year may be submitted and will not be subjected to oral defense provided that the proposed innovation, intervention and strategy is still relevant and serves as the immediate concern of the proponent in his/her class.
- 7. To qualify for approval, the proponent must have a minimum score of 70% as stated in DepEd Order No. 16, s. 2017.
