SUBJECT: ADDENDUM TO DIVISION MEMORANDUM NO. 290, S. 2024
(Curriculum Implementation Division Activities for the Month of July 2024)

PARTICULARS

1. In relation to the issued Division Memorandum No. 290, s. 2024 dated June 28, 2024 titled *Curriculum Implementation Division Activities for the Month of July 2024*, this memorandum aims to provide additional information about the conduct of Alternative Learning System (ALS) Activities.
2. In cognizance to Republic Act 11510, the Alternative Learning System Act which declared the policy of the State to promote the right of all citizens to quality education at all levels and take appropriate steps to make such education accessible to all, the conduct of Community Literacy Mapping and Recruitment of Learners from July 8-19, 2024 is geared towards providing support in the attainment of universalization of Basic Education with the involvement of LGU and Barangay Officials to assist in the conduct of the said mapping.
3. Other objectives of the activity are as follows;
 - a. Guarantee equitable access to all learners, including those who reside in the unreached and underserved communities to avail systematic, flexible and appropriate flexible learning options;
 - b. Promote lifelong learning opportunities and elevate socio-economic status, raise level of literacy and contribute to an individual's sustainable future by paving the way for completion of basic education outside of the formal system;
 - c. Determine the number of Out-of-School Children (OSCs), Out-of-School Youth (OSYs) and Out-of-School Adults (OSAs) who need basic education and literacy.
4. Participants to the activity include the ALS Focal Person, Education Program Specialists II, Public Schools District Supervisors, School Heads In-charge of ALS, ALS & BPOSA teachers, Teachers in the formal system and other ALS implementers.



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4. ALS Teachers, EPSAs and School Heads will be granted a maximum of ten (10) days Compensatory Overtime Credits (COC) in lieu of overtime pay in accordance with Civil Service Commission and Department of Budget and Management Joint Circular No. 2, s. 2004 - "Non-Monetary Remuneration for Overtime Service Rendered." Teachers from the formal system shall likewise be entitled to a maximum ten (10) days Service Credits as per DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2003 titled, "Updated Guidelines on Grant of Vacation Service Credits to Teachers".
5. Appropriate Means of Verification (MOVs) and reports shall be accomplished by the participants in order to be granted with the Compensatory Overtime Credits or Service Credits.
6. Immediate and wide dissemination of this memorandum is desired.
