SUBJECT: DIVISION SEMINAR ON THE ORGANIZATION & MANAGEMENT

OF COACHES AND TECHNICAL OFFICIALS IN TABLE TENNIS

- In line with the division's continuous efforts to enhance the skills and knowledge of coaches in the field of sports, the Schools Division Office of Pangasinan II shall conduct a specialized training seminar titled Division Seminar on the Organization and Management of Coaches and Technical Officials in Table Tennis. This training aims to equip teacher-coaches with the latest techniques and strategies to improve athletic performance and overall well-being of student-athletes.
- The training shall be conducted on October 23-25, 2024 at Juan C. Laya Central School Sped Center, San Manuel, Pangasinan.
- 3. The training shall observe these objectives:

 - b. explore innovative approaches.
 - c. connect with other coaches, sports professionals, and experts in the field to exchange ideas, share experiences, and build a network for future collaboration.
 - d. gain insights from experienced speakers and presenters, extracting practical knowledge that can be applied directly to coaching practices.
 - e. learn from success stories and case studies to understand best practices and avoid common pitfalls.
- School heads are requested to ensure the participation of the selected teachercoaches and members of the technical working group. All involved personnel shall therefore arrange their contingency plans for the first day of the training to ensure continuity of classes and office functions.
