2024 Division PASIKAT Festival of Talents Competition SUBJECT:

PARTICULARS

1. Pursuant to Presidential Proclamation N. 683 dated January 28,1991, entitled Declaring the Month of February of every year as National Arts Month. It is an avenue to promote and provide positive exposure to talented Filipino artists. It allows them to showcase their creativity.

2. Relative to this, the MAPEH & SPA Department of the SDO of Pangasinan II will conduct the annual 2024 PASIKAT (Pangasinan II Artistic Showcase of Innate Knowledge and Talents) Festival of Talents Competition. (See attached Enclosure on the schedule of activities and guidelines and mechanics of the different contests).

3. Focused on the theme, "DDS- Discover, Develop and Showcase" the talents of our learners, 2024 Division PASIKAT Festival of Talents Competition aims to harvest the diversity of expressions that can be part of values education for patriotism, cultural identity, and love of country. Specifically, this activity has the following objectives:

a. Cultivate appreciation for the arts and bring out a deep sense of respect for our culture and traditions;

b. Discover and develop the Art potentials of our learners;

c. Showcase and promote local culture and arts scene through songs, dances and artworks.

4. Participation to said activity is on voluntary basis. Student participants should submit Parents Permit, Medical record/certificate to their coaches. Coach/trainer or accompanying teacher should secure a Vehicle Transport Safety Certificate from rented / hired vehicle.

5. Travel expenses & other incidental expenses of the participants shall be charged against local school funds or MOOE subject to the usual auditing and accounting procedures.

6. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.

GENERAL GUIDELINES

ELEMENTARY

- One entry per district. No District elimination, no participation to Congressional and Division level. District level elimination/District Arts Festival of Talents will be held on or before the Cluster PASIKAT Festival of Talents to select the entries/contestants per District per event for the Congressional level.
- 2. The Cluster PASIKAT Festival of Talents Competition will be held on January 18-19,2025 at SM Event Rosales, Pangasinan with the scheduled events:

January `18...... Song and Musical Instruments playing Contests:

- 1. Vocal Solo (learner & teacher category)
- 2. Himig-Bulilit
- 3. Solo-Instrument Playing
- 4. Group Instrument Playing
- 5. Rondalla

January 19......Dance Contests

- 1. Hip Hop
- 2. Ballroom
- 3. Top Three winners from each cluster per event and first place winners from private Schools will be selected per event to head up to the next level on the Division PASIKAT Festival of Talents.
- 4. Cluster and Division contest registration fee is one hundred pesos (Php 100.00) for the each in the elementary (participant and the coach), which could be charged to local school funds, canteen funds and other sources while travel expenses relative to this activity could be charged to the school MOOE subject to the accounting & auditing rules. The registration fee is to be used for Judge's honorarium and accommodation, medals, certificates, accommodation/meals of TWG.
- 5. The Division PASIKAT Festival of Talents Competition- Elementary will be held on February 14-15, 2025 at SM Event Center, Rosales, Pangasinan.
- **6.** Participants should not be a Grand winner/champion (First place) of any Provincial, National or International competition for the past 3 years.
- 7. FIRST PLACE WINNER in the previous Division Arts Festival of Talents (2023) Vocal Solo Contest (Learner & Teacher category) are not allowed to join to give more chance to others.

- 8. Participants must be bonafide Elementary (Kinder to Grade 6); learners of the school. Proof of enrollment or Certification from the School Head shall be provided to the Contest Chairman on the contest day.
- 9. For teacher participant must be a regular/permanent employee (Teaching personnel only). Individual contest should have 1 coach while group contest should have 2 coaches.
- 10. The participation of the learner is voluntary and supported with parent/guardian's permit. Rehearsals should be done after class hours or during weekends with parents permit.
- 11. Performers should not wear any attire with the name/identification/logo of the school/municipality/organization.
- 12. Any violation from the contest mechanics shall be subjected to corresponding deductions. One point deduction per violation from the total scores.
- 13. Top(5) five winners will be awarded certificate of recognition, Top (3) three will be awarded certificate of recognition and medals.
- 14. The decision of the judges is final and irrevocable.
- 15. PINTAHUSAY and KATUTUBONG SAYAW(FOLK DANCE) are the only events to be contested for Elementary for the Regional Arts Festival of Talents which will be held on February 14-16,2025 at Dagupan City. For this purpose, the Division Contest/Elimination for Katutubong Sayaw and PINTAHUSAY will be held on January 28,2025 at Mangaldan NHS. No more cluster elimination for these 2 events. Each district should have one entry per event for the PINTAHUSAY AND KATUTUBONG SAYAW.

SECONDARY

GENERAL GUIDELINES

- 1. One entry per school in every contest. **School level elimination/School Arts Festival of Talents** will be conducted to select the entries/contestants for the Congressional level.
- 2. Cluster PASIKAT Festival of Talents will be held on January 28, 30 & 31,2025 to select the entry for the Division level on the following venues:

CLUSTER A:

Mangaldan, Manaoag, San Jacinto, San Fabian, Laoac, Binalonan

CLUSTER B:

Pozorrubio, Sto. Tomas, Alcala, Bautista, Rosales, Sison, Asingan, Villasis

CLUSTER C:

Balungao, San Manuel, Sta. Maria, San Quintin, Tayug, San Nicolas, Umingan, Natividad

- 3. Top Three (3) winners from each Cluster and top 1 from private schools will joining the next level on the Division PASIKAT Festival of Talents.
 - 4. Cluster Registration fee is one hundred pesos (Php 100.00) each secondary (participant and the coach), which could be charged to local school funds, canteen funds and other sources while travel expenses relative to this activity could be charged to the school MOOE subject to the accounting & auditing rules. The registration fee is to be used for Judge's honorarium and accommodation, medals, certificates, accommodation/meals of TWG.

- 5. The Division PASIKAT Festival of Talents Camp will be held on February 21-23, 2025 at Laoac NHS, Laoac, Pangasinan.
- 6. The Division PASIKAT FESTIVAL OF TALENTS CAMP is a yearly activity conducted to provide positive exposure to our talented learners in performing and visual arts.
- LIKHA (LINANGIN ANG ISIPAN NG HUWARANG ARTISTS) contests and exhibit will be conducted. A separate Contest mechanics and Guidelines for this will be posted.
- 8. Division Registration fee is two hundred pesos (Php 200.00) each secondary (participant and the coach), which could be charged to local school funds, canteen funds and other sources while travel expenses relative to this activity could be charged to the school MOOE subject to the accounting & auditing rules. The registration fee is to be used for Judge's honorarium and accommodation, medals, certificates, accommodation/meals of TWG
- 9. The contests in the Division level will be in two categories:
 - 1. Newly Nationalized (EO 189) & Integrated School
 - 2. Big, Large and Mega School, Special Program for the Arts (SPA) & Private School.

NOTE: ALL SPA SCHOOLS WILL BE HEADING TO THE DIVISION LEVEL, FOR CLUSTER ELIMINATION, ONLY THE REGULAR MAPEH SCHOOLS WILL BE COMPETING.

- 10. Participants should not be a Grand winner/champion-First Place of any Provincial, National or International competition.
- 11. FIRST PLACE WINNER in the previous Division Arts Festival of Talents (2023-2024) Vocal Solo Contest (Leaner & Teacher category) are not allowed to join to give more chance to others.
- 12. The contest is open to all Learners from Grades 7-12 both public and private. Participants must be bonafide learners from JHS and/or SHS of the school. Proof of enrollment or Certification from the School Head shall be provided to the Contest Chairman on the contest proper. For teacher participant, he/she must be a regular/permanent employee(Teaching personnel only).

- 13. All events should be participated by JHS and SHS. The management discouraged joining all the events by 100 % participants coming from SHS Learners or coming from JHS Learners only. It should be participated by JHS and SHS Leaners.
- 14. The **participation of the learner is voluntary** and supported with parent/guardian's permit. Rehearsals should be done after class hours or during weekends with parent's permit.
- 15. Performers should not wear any attire with the name/identification/logo of the school municipality/organization.
- 16. Individual contest should have 1 coach while group contest should have 2 coaches.
- 17. Top (5) five winners will be awarded certificate of recognition, Top (3) three will be awarded certificate of recognition and medals.
- 14.Any violation from the contest mechanics shall be subject to corresponding deductions. One point deduction per violation from the total scores.
- 15. The decision of the judges is final and irrevocable.
- 16. The following events will be contested in the School/Cluster and Division level:

- 1. Vocal Solo (learner & teacher category)
- 2. Acapella
- 3. Solo-Instrument Playing
- 4. Group Instrument Playing

- 3. Ballroom
