#### **PARTICULARS**

1. The Department of Education (DepEd) SDO Pangasinan II, through the Curriculum Implementation Division, announces the division participation in the 2025 Regional Festival Of Talents (RFOT) with the theme "Empowering Filipino Youth: Unleashing Potentials in Creative Industries in the Era of AI".

- 2. ### 2025 REGIONAL FESTIVAL OF TALENTS

To: Schools Division Superintendents

- 1. The Department of Education Regional Office 1 (DepEd-RO1), through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD), will conduct the 2025 Regional Festival of Talents (RFOT) with the theme "Empowering Filipino Youth: Unleashing Potentials in Creative Industries in the Era of AI" at the Schools Division Office of Dagupan City, Dagupan City, Pangasinan on February 11-12, 2025 (exclusive of travel time).
- 2. As provided in the Republic Act (RA) 10533 titled: An Act Enhancing the Philippine Basic Education System by Strengthening Its Curriculum and Increasing the Number of Years for Basic Education, Appropriating Funds Therefore and for Other Purposes, and DepEd Order (DO) No. 021, s. 2019, titled Policy Guidelines on the K to 12 Basic Education Program, consistent with the DepEd goal of producing functionally literate and holistically developed Filipinos, all RFOT events are aligned with the essential learning competencies and standards of the K to 12 curriculum.
- 3. DepEd is expected to help achieve the much-needed protection and preference of local creatives and products, with the passing of RA 11904, also known as the Philippine Creative Industries Development Act. Hence, RFOT shall contribute toward the goal of enhancing learners' competence in creative industries.
- 4. The RFOT, is DepEd-RO1 annual co-curricular activity that provide meaningful learning opportunities for basic education learners to display their talents and skills anchored on the learning competencies achieved in schools. It guides learners on which career path to take relevant to the four curriculum exits (higher education, middle-level skills development, entrepreneurship, and employment) of the Enhanced K to 12 Basic Education Program. Likewise, RFOT serves as a culminating activity of gauging learning mastery and skill development in accordance with learning standards.
- 5. Participants in RFOT are learners from public and private elementary and secondary schools who will showcase their talents and skills and explore the culture of the host division. Together with their respective teacher-coaches, they shall listen to the invaluable insights to be shared by the invited panel of experts after their performance; thereby, strengthening the teaching and learning of target learning competencies.
- 6. Participation in the 2025 RFOT is **voluntary** and shall not, in any way, affect the time-on-task of teachers as this activity's target learning standards and competencies are already embedded in teachers' actual classroom teaching and assessment process.

- 7. To ensure the safety, health, and well-being of all RFOT participants and delegates, strict observance of minimum health protocols shall be implemented within all activity premises.
- 8. The events of the 2025 RFOT shall be conducted in-person. Specific details and all the procedures on the conduct can be found in Enclosure No. 1: General Guidelines and Enclosure No. 2: Specific Guidelines for Skills Exhibition for Each Event Category.
- 9. There shall be **no registration fee** for the 2025 RFOT. Materials needed for the event exhibition, travel expenses, meals and other incidental expenses of learner-participants, teacher-coaches, and other official delegates shall be charged to **their local funds** or **other eligible fund sources**, subject to the usual government accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
